NOTE:	The instructions are based on the existing selection rules. Amendments made by Government of Karnataka from time to time and any other law that will be in force at the appropriate stage will apply.

Candidates are neither required to send any certificates/documents in support of their claim in the online application nor printout of their Application Form (Final Printout) to KEA. However the candidates, in their own interest, must satisfy themselves about their eligibility for the Test / admission to relevant courses. In the event of any ineligibility being detected by the Government / KEA / University / Apex Body at any stage, their candidature will be cancelled and they shall be liable for legal action.

INTRODUCTION

As per Government order No. MED 122 RGU 2020, Bangalore dated 21-10-2020 and Government letter No. HFW 150 PTD 2020 dated 21-10-2020, Karnataka Examinations Authority will be conducting PG Entrance Test for admission to PG courses in M.Sc Nursing, MPT, M.Pharm and Pharm-D (Post Bacculaureate), for the seats in Government Colleges and Government seats in Private Aided/Unaided Minority & Non-minority Colleges in Karnataka for the academic year 2020-21. The eligible candidates of Karnataka origin passed the qualifying examination in the colleges located in Karnataka state willing to appear for the test may fill the application form online on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> from **23-10-2020 to 01-11-2020**.

PG Entrance Exam will be conducted on **22-11-2020 from 10.30 am to 12.00 Noon only in Bangalore.**

For admission to M.Sc. Nursing and MPT, M.Sc. Allied Sciences candidate should have obtained at-least 40% in the entrance examination as per Government order No. MED 122 RGU 2020, Bangalore dated 21-10-2020.

1. Introduction:

Post Graduate Entrance Test-2020 is being conducted for the purpose of determining the eligibility for admission of students to M.Sc (Nursing) / MPT / M.Pharm / Pharm-D (Post Baccalaureate) courses in Government / Private / Aided / Unaided Minority/Non-Minority Nursing, Physiotherapy, Pharmacy Colleges within the State of Karnataka for the academic year 2020-21.

Post Graduate Entrance Test is being conducted for admission to Post Graduate Courses in Government colleges and Government seats in Private Colleges, in accordance with the Government Orders No. HFW 14 RGU 2018, Bangalore, dated: 26-03-2018. The details and instructions contained in this Brochure are subject to the Government orders issued from time to time.

2. Eligibility:

Candidate who fulfills the following criteria is eligible to appear for the Entrance Test:

a. M. Sc. Nursing:

- (i) Candidate should be a citizen of India
- (ii) Candidate should have passed B.Sc Nursing (Basic) or B.Sc. Hons. Nursing or Post Basic B.Sc. in Nursing degree or Post Certificate B.Sc Nursing with a minimum of 55% aggregate marks from Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka (RGUHS), or any other University located in Karnataka state, accepted as equivalent by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka. The institution should have been recognized by Indian Nursing Council. SC/ST candidates should have a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.
- (iii)
 - a. Passed B.Sc. Nursing (Basic) or Post Basic B.Sc. in Nursing degree or Post Certificate B.Sc. Nursing of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka (RGUHS), or any other University accepted as equivalent by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.
 - b. ***Minimum of one year of experience after obtaining B.Sc. Nursing (Basic), in a Hospital or in Nursing educational Institution or Community Health setting (completed or completing on or before Date of Counselling.*** For candidate with Post Basic B.Sc. in Nursing Degree no such experience is needed after graduation.
- (iv) Candidate should have registered in State Nursing Council as a Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife.
- (v) Shall be a registered nurse and registered midwife for admission to branches.
 - I. Medical Surgical Nursing
 - II. Community Health Nursing
 - III. Pediatric Nursing
 - IV. Obstetrics and Gynecology Nursing
 - V. Psychiatric Nursing
- (vi) The Candidate should not have attained the age of 45 years on the last date fixed for submission of application to PG Degree Entrance Test.

b. Master of Physiotherapy:

- (i) Candidate should be a citizen of India.
- (ii) Candidate who has passed or appearing the examination/internship B.Sc. (PT) or BPT degree from this University or any other University located in Karnataka state recognized as equivalent by RGUHS with not less than 50% of marks in aggregate are eligible. And such applicants should produce all documents including internship on or before counseling date.
- (iii) The Candidate should not have attained the age of 45 years on the last date fixed for submission of application to PG Degree Entrance Test.
- (iv) Candidates who have completed or are completing Internship on or before date of counseling.

Government of Karnataka In-Service Candidates:

In addition to the above, the In-service candidates have to fulfill the following conditions for admission to Post-Graduate courses in Nursing and Physiotherapy. It is mandatory for the In-service candidates to appear for the entrance test.

1. An In-service candidate who is already holding a Post Graduate Degree in any specialty shall not be eligible for admission to any other Post Graduate Degree.
2. An In-service candidate who is studying in any Post Graduate Degree course shall not be eligible for admission.
3. No candidate who is above 45 years as on the last date fixed for receipt of application shall be eligible for admission. (***For In-service candidates 48 years***).
4. The eligibility for appearance of in-service candidates in PGET is subject to the provisions of KCSR's and relevant Government Rules/Notifications governing state services.
5. The Eligible In-Service candidates who is willing to apply for M.Sc Nursing & MPT Should submit application with all necessary information to DME and DME in turn should send the list of Eligible candidates.

Government In-service - Physiotherapists & Nurses should apply through proper channel i.e. (concerned Heads of Department) and also should furnish the following information:

1. Whether they have been deputed to any postgraduate degree courses earlier by the Government
2. Whether they belong to SC / ST category
3. Whether any enquiry is pending against him / her
4. Whether he / she is under suspension / unauthorized absence

C. M. Pharm

- i. Candidate should be a citizen of India.
- ii. Candidate should have born in the Karnataka state.*
- iii. Candidate should have passed B.Pharm Degree examination of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, or B.Pharm examination of any other recognized Indian University established by law located in Karnataka state or any other degree courses in Pharmacy in an institutions located in Karnataka state recognized as equivalent by RGUHS, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) or All India Council of Technical Education (A.I.C.T.E.) for this purpose and who has secured not less than 55% of the maximum marks ,50% in case of SC/ST Cat-I (aggregate of four years) prescribed for the Qualifying examination shall be eligible for the admission to the M.Pharm course.
- iv. Candidate who have completed or are completing Industrial training on or before 31st July 2019 are eligible for Entrance Test.
- v. Provided candidates who are in the final year of B.Pharm course in colleges recognized by PCI and AICT are also eligible to appear for the Entrance Test under these Regulations.”
- (As per G.O. No. HFW 290 PTD 2012, dated: 24-02-2015).
- vi. The candidates who have appeared for the qualifying B.Pharm examination and waiting for the results should submit the result copy at the time of verification along with the photocopy of Hall ticket for having attended the Final B.Pharm Examination at the time of Verification, otherwise the candidates shall loose the Eligibility for PGET.
- vii. Candidate should not have attained the age of 45 years on the last date fixed for submission of application of PG Entrance Test.

* Candidates born in Karnataka means candidates of Karnataka origin or his or her parents (father or mother) has been a resident of Karnataka State for a period of not less than ten years and who produces a certificate from the concerned Tahashildar to that effect.

d. Pharm -D (Post Bacculaureate):

- (i) Candidate should be a citizen of India.
- (ii) Candidate should have born in the Karnataka state.*
- (iii) Candidate should have passed B.Pharm Degree examination from affiliated Colleges of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, or any other approved Board or University established by law located in Karnataka or any other degree courses in Pharmacy in an institutions located in Karnataka recognized as equivalent by RGUHS, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) or All India Council of Technical Education (A.I.C.T.E.) for this purpose and who has secured not less than 55% of the maximum marks (aggregate of four years) prescribed for the qualification examination shall be eligible for the admission to the Pharma-D (Post Bacculaureate) course.
- (iv) For SC/ST & Category-I (Karnataka) candidates, the prescribed percentage of marks will be 50% of the maximum marks in the qualifying examination.
- (v) Candidate who have completed or completing Industrial training on or before 31st July 2019 are eligible for Entrance Test provided, candidates who are in the final year of B.Pharm course in colleges recognized by PCI are also eligible to appear for the Entrance Test under this Regulation.” (As per G.O. No. HFW 290 PTD 2012, dated 24-02-2015).
- (vi) The candidates who have written the qualifying B.Pharm examination and waiting for the results should submit the result copy at the time of verification along with the photocopy of Hall ticket for having attended the Final B.Pharm Examination, otherwise the candidates shall loose the Eligibility for PGET.
- (vii) Candidate should not have attained the age of 45 years on the last date fixed for submission of application of PG Entrance Test.

* Candidates born in Karnataka means candidates of Karnataka origin who or his or her parents (father or mother) has been a resident of Karnataka State for a period of not less than ten years and who produces a certificate from the concerned Tahashildar to that effect.

Government of Karnataka In-Service Candidates: (If applicable)

In addition to the above, the In-service candidates have to fulfill the following conditions for admission to Post-Graduate courses in Pharmacy. It is mandatory for the In-service candidates to appear for the Entrance Test.

1. An In-service candidate who is already holding a Post Graduate Degree in any specialty shall not be eligible for admission to any other Post Graduate Degree.
2. An In-service candidate who is studying in any Post Graduate Degree course shall not be eligible for admission.
3. No candidate who is above 45 years as on the last date fixed for receipt of application shall be eligible for admission.
4. The eligibility for appearance of In-service candidates in PGET is subject to the provisions of KCSR's and relevant Government Rules/Notifications governing state services.

Government In-service - Pharmacists should apply through proper channel i.e. (concerned Heads of Department) and also should furnish the following information:

1. Whether they have been deputed to any postgraduate degree courses earlier by the Government
2. Whether they belong to SC / ST category
3. Whether any enquiry is pending against him / her
4. Whether he / she is under suspension / unauthorized absence

For Physically Disability category:

(Seats will be allotted depending on the availability of seats as per Seat Matrix published by Government of Karnataka)

“Candidates with Physical Disability ranging above 40% should produce a Medical Certificate issued by Chairman, State Disability Board or any equivalent authority of State of Karnataka in the field of concerned disability along with the application form for the entrance test. Candidates suffering from hearing disability should compulsorily obtain and produce a BSER (Brain Stem Evoked Response) Audiometry Report from NIMHANS/Manipal Hospital/Government Speech and Hearing Institute, Lingarajapuram, Bangalore. At the time of counseling, the candidates required to appear for medical examination before a Committee comprising of the Registrar, RGUHS, Bangalore, as Chairman and three specialists from the department of Orthopedics, Ophthalmology and ENT. The Medical Board shall examine the candidate and certify regarding the percentage of disability and the decision of the Medical Board will be final. For the purpose of this provision, persons with the disability shall have the same meaning assigned to it in the ‘Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Participation) Act 1995 (Central Act 1/1995). The candidates with disability less than 40% will not be eligible for claiming a seat under Physically Disabled Category. The candidates selecting seat under PH quota are ineligible to select a seat in the consequent round of counseling”.

NOTE: The Physically Disabled candidates who fail to appear before the committee on the day fixed for medical examination will not be eligible for selection of a seat under Physically Disabled quota

3. Application Form:

Guidelines to fill the online Application form: -

Note: Since the Applicant should upload their photographs in online application entry, the applicant should scan their passport size photograph (Snapped after 01/10/2020 with Name & Date on the photograph) in .jpg format and make available for uploading with the following specifications.

After filling the online application form press SUBMIT button, if you are sure that all the data entered by you is correct. The system will ask for uploading photograph and the scanned photograph of .jpg format file with the above mentioned specification has to be uploaded. An Application Number will get generated and please record it for your future usage. In-service candidates should submit their applications through the concerned Head of the Department and no advance copy will be entertained.

Please note that the candidate will not become eligible for attending the entrance test only by online registration.

Candidates have to apply online for admission to the above Courses through KEA.

While entering the details online or after completion of the entry of application online, do not attach any certificates or documents or papers or do not send certificates to KEA in support of your claim in the application. But at this stage candidate has to mention his / her claim of reservation invariably to which he / she is eligible without fail. Further, possessing of certificates may not be required while entering the reservation details, but the relevant original certificates has to be submitted at the time of document verification in support of their claim made in the online application form.

receive an Application number and User-ID to their registered mobile phone number and email-id and also same will be displayed on the screen. Later on candidates have to create their own password for further entry of online application.

Step 3: A Login Prompt will be displayed and candidates are required to enter the User ID and Password created by them and Login.

Step 4: On successful login by the candidates "Student information" will be displayed, in which the candidates have to start entering the required information.

Step 5: Once the candidates complete the student information entries, they will have to save the entries made.

Step 6: The candidates will enter the all the study details and select "save and next" button.

Step 7: After successful saving the study details, the candidates will have to upload the scanned images of Photograph, candidate signature, candidate Left Hand Thumb Impression and Parent Signature and select "save and next" button.

After completion of the above steps, the candidates have take the Draft Printout, carefully verify the entries made by them and if any changes are required they can do so by login in any number of times before selecting the declaration.

Second Phase:

In this phase, the candidate will select the declaration, read and understand it completely and then select "Submit" button. After submission select the bank challan, download and take a printout of the challan and make the payment in the respective bank.

Step 1: After completion of entry of all the details candidate's will receive an application ID and Password to their registered email address and also the same information will be displayed on the screen.

Step 2: Candidates have to upload the scanned copy of recent passport size Colour Photograph and Signature in JPG / JPEG format separately. (Photograph Captured on the mobile phone can also be updated)

Step 3: Candidates have to take the printout of the Challan copy which is in triplicate. Candidates of Karnataka origin have to pay prescribed fee. The candidates have to pay the requisite fee in any of the branch of specified Banks. The bank will retain their copy of the Challan respectively and handover the remaining two copies of the Challan to the candidates. Or the candidates can pay the fees through net-banking.

IMPORTANT:

IF ANY OF THE INFORMATION FURNISHED IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM IS FOUND TO BE FALSE / INCORRECT, THE APPLICATION IS LIABLE TO BE REJECTED AT ANY POINT OF TIME and the seat selected by the candidate, if any, is also liable to be cancelled at any stage and the entire fee amount paid by such candidate shall be forfeited.

5. Reservation in favour of certain categories:

- Orders issued by Government of Karnataka from time to time for reservation in seats for constitutionally permissible classes of Karnataka candidates such as SC and ST and Category I, IIA, IIB, IIIA and IIIB, are applicable. Failure to produce the latest income and category certificate issued by Tahashildar of Karnataka will result in forfeiture of his/her claim for reservation and he/she will be considered as a candidate belonging to General Category only. Requests for change of category will not be entertained after submission of the application.
- **The candidates claiming Reservation under Hyderabad Karnataka Region.**

The candidates claiming Reservation under Hyderabad Karnataka Region as local persons should produce the relevant certificate issued by the Jurisdictional Assistant Commissioner of the Revenue Sub-Division for claiming reservation under Article 371J (Hyderabad - Karnataka Region). Non production of the certificate during Document Verification will result to rejection of his claim.

7. General Information:

- A. The candidates shall appear for the Entrance Test at their own cost.

All the marks cards and certificates submitted along with the application are subject to verification at the initial stage for Registration and issue of Hall Ticket for the Entrance Test. Detailed verification will be made before the candidate is allowed for seat selection. It is the responsibility of the candidate to furnish all original marks cards and certificates for verification at the time of seat selection. Failure to produce the originals for any reason will result in forfeiture of his/her claim for selection of seat.

Failure to produce valid Income and Category Certificate issued by the Tahashildar will result in forfeiture of his/her claim for reservation and he/she will be considered as a candidate belonging to General category only. 8. Conduct of Entrance Test:

The Examination will be conducted at Predetermined Test Centers at Bangalore only. The details of Test Centre will be intimated in the Hall Ticket. The place & date will be intimated in the KEA website.

■ Syllabus: M.Sc. Nursing / M.P.T.

The Syllabus content will ordinarily be equal to the syllabus prescribed for the particular degree courses as the case may be under apex body regulations and RGUHS Ordinances.

Syllabus: M.Pharm / Pharm-D (PB)

The Syllabus content will ordinarily be equal to the syllabus prescribed for the particular degree courses as the case may be under apex body regulations and KEA Ordinances.

Subject wise distribution of marks for Entrance Test: Four departments exist in pharmacy namely Pharmaceutics, Pharmacognosy, Pharmachemistry and Pharmacology. Total 100 questions will be selected by giving 25 question weightage to each department. For both the Courses (M.Pharm & Pharm.D (PB)), same question paper will be set as the minimum eligibility for both the courses is B. Pharm.

▪ **Duration, Nature of Question Paper:**

- i. The Entrance Test will be conducted in English.
- ii. There will be one Question Paper (booklet) consisting of 100 questions with duration of 90 minutes.
- iii. Questions will be of objective type, each question having one best response out of four possible alternatives
- iv. Each question carries one mark. Correct answer will be awarded- one mark. If more than one alternative is marked for a question, it will be treated as wrong answer. Wrong answers carry no marks.

Determination of Merit and Publication of Results:

- a) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test.
- b) Provisional Merit lists will be published in the KEA website.
- c) The minimum percentage of marks for eligibility for admission is 50% for General Merit candidates and 40% for candidates belonging to SC, ST and OBC categories.

C. Computation of result Criteria:

- i. $\geq 50\%$ in PGET for "GM" and $\geq 40\%$ in PGET for "SC, ST & OBC"
- ii. Marks Secured in PGET (1st Order) – Descending
- iii. If candidates have secured same marks in PGET then go to Total No. of Attempts taken in UG (2nd Order) – Ascending
- iv. If candidates have secured same marks in PGET & same Total No. of attempts taken in UG then go to % of total marks secured in UG (3rd Order) – Descending
- v. If candidates have secured same marks in PGET, same Total No. of attempts taken in UG & same % of total marks in UG then go to % of final year marks secured in UG (4th Order) – Descending.

NOTE: For admission to M.Sc. Nursing and MPT, candidate should have obtained at-least 40% in the entrance examination as per Government order No. MED 122 RGU 2020, Bangalore dated 21-10-2020.

9. Counseling & Seat Selection: the counseling will be conducted online

The Counseling dates for each faculty will be published in the KEA Website. No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates.

10. Availability of Seats in different courses and colleges:

Details of the precise number of seats in different courses and colleges, their classification and category wise reservation will be announced as soon as the receipt of it from Government.

11. Instructions to Candidates:

The candidates shall be present at the centre 30 minutes before the commencement of the test.

Only the candidates who possess the Hall Ticket shall be allowed to appear for the Entrance Test. In case of loss of Hall Ticket, the candidates should contact the Chief Superintendent of the centre one hour earlier for assistance.

No Candidate shall copy from the paper of any other candidate or permit his / her own papers to be copied or attempt to give or seek any illegal assistance.

No candidate will be admitted to the examination hall after the commencement of the Entrance Test.

No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of the first thirty minutes. Candidates leaving the hall prior to the end of the Entrance Test will have to hand over the question paper sheet to room invigilator and collect the same at the end of the test.

Candidate should sign the attendance sheet as per the instructions of the invigilator.

Silence must be observed in the examination hall. Any candidate found guilty of disorderly or improper conduct will be liable for expulsion from the examination hall and will be debarred from the Entrance test by the Chief Superintendent of the centre.
