NOTIFICATION

Sub: Publication of intake and seat matrix of B.Sc. Allied Health Sciences Courses in Government and Private Colleges, during the academic year 2020-21.

- The Notification for Publication of intake and seat matrix of B.Sc. Allied Health Sciences Courses in Government and Private Colleges, during the academic year 2020-21 referred at (1) above has been withdrawn.
- In the Ordinances pertaining to the Regulations and Curriculum for 2) Bachelors of Science Degree in Allied Health Sciences and further amendments issued by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, regulating the manner of admission and eligibility to the Allied Health Sciences courses.
- While issuing the order for granting affiliation to the Government 3) and Private Colleges for sanction of new courses or additional courses or increase of seats of Allied Health Science courses, the State Government has imposing condition about percentage of seats to be surrendered to the Government Quota in the sanctioned intake. As per that, all the seats in the Government Colleges and 20% seats from the private colleges have to be filled through Government Quota.
- Under section-45 (10) (b) of RGUHS Act, 1994 the intake in respect 4) of each of the Allied Health Science courses will have to be determined and the total number of seats under Government seat category for admission to such courses both in Government and in private Colleges shall be notified by Government from time to time.





- 5) As per Government order HFW 84 MMC 2019, Dated: 31.08.2019 Directorate of Medical Education shall conduct the counseling for allotment to the 1st year Allied Health Science courses in Government Colleges and Government seats in private allied health sciences colleges from the academic year 2020-21.
- Now, therefore Government of Karnataka under section 45 (10) (b) of the RGUHS Act, 1994 hereby notifies particulars of the courses and reservation of seats for the SCs / STs / OBCs and other special categories as applicable for the academic session 2020-21 as specified in the Annexure 1 to 4 appended to this notification.
- 7) The fee structure chargeable to the candidates seeking admission to Allied Health Science courses under Government Quota in the current academic year 2020-21 is on par with fees fixed by the Bangalore Medical College & Research Institute.
