NOTIFICATION

Sub:- Publication of intake and Seat matrix of B.Sc Nursing Course in Government and Private Nursing colleges for the academic year 2023-24.

1) The Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses Rules, 2003 have been promulgated by the Government of Karnataka in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 145 (1) of the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and section 14 of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (prohibition of capitation fee) Act, 1984. These rules have come into force from 03-07-2003, the date on which they were published in the Karnataka Gazette under Notification No: HFW 44 MPS 2003 (2), dated:03.07.2003 and applicable from the academic session 2003-04 regulating the manner of admission to the aforesaid Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses and the structure of fee chargeable from the students seeking admission to such courses.

2) The Karnataka Selection of the Candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy Courses (Amendment) Rules, 2003, have been enacted which came in to force from 12-11-2003, the date on which they were published in the Karnataka Gazette under Notification No. HFW 179 PTD 2005, dated 19-04-2007 amending the seat sharing ratio to 20:80 between the Government and the Management.

3) Under section 45 (10) (b) of RGUHS Act, 1994 the intake in respect of each of the B.Sc. Nursing will have to be determined and the total number of seats under Government seat category for admission to such courses both in Government and in private Colleges shall be notified by Government from time to time.

4) The Government of Karnataka under rule 7 and 9 of the Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses Rules, 2003, read with section 45 (10) (b) of the RGUHS Act, 1994 hereby notifies particulars of the courses and reservation of seats for the SCs/STs/OBCs and other

special categories as applicable for the academic session 2023-24 as specified in the Annexure-1 to 5 appended to this notification.

5) As per Government Order No.MED 299 MSF 2023, Dated:28.07.2023 referred at (4) above, the fee structure chargeable to the candidates seeking admission to B.Sc Nursing under Government Quota in the current academic year 2023-24 as follows.

6) As per Government order HFW 84 MMC 2019, Dated: 31.08.2019, Directorate of Medical Education shall conduct the counseling in Co-ordination with Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) for allotment to the 1st year B.Sc Nursing courses in Government and Private Nursing Colleges from the academic year 2019-20

8) The Selection of candidates for allotment to 1st year B.Sc. Nursing Course shall be strictly in conformity with the provisions contained in the Karnataka Selection of candidates for admission to Nursing, Pharmacy and Physiotherapy courses, Rules, 2003.
