Preamble:

- 1) Admission of PG Courses in Nursing Courses is governed by the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for admission to M.Sc., Nursing Degree Course Rules, 1995.
- 2) In Govt. Order dated 03/12/2003, it was ordered that 50% of the intake of M.Sc., Nursing and MPT in Private Nursing, & Physiotherapy Colleges shall be Govt. seats and candidates shall be selected for allotment to the said colleges for admission in Govt. seats under Govt. quota during 2003-2004 by adopting the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for admission to Nursing and Physiotherapy courses Rules, 2003 for the purpose of adopting the procedure for selection of candidates and applicability of reservation etc.
- 3) In Govt. Order No.HFW 2 MPS 2003, dated 24/12/2003 the Director of Medical Education was empowered as the authority for sponsoring the candidates against Government seats in the above Private Colleges.
- 4) In the Govt. Order dated 01/04/2004, it has been ordered to select the candidates for admission to the following PG courses by adopting and enforcing the mode of Selection of Candidates during the academic year 2004-2005 which was prevalent during the preceding academic year 2003-2004 invoking the aforesaid rules now in force by sharing the seats in the ratio of 50:50 between Government and Management in the respective Private Colleges, through counselling by the Director of Medical Education.
 - (1) M.Sc., Nursing
 - (2) MPT.
- 5) The criteria for Selection of Candidates and the authorities competent to conduct the counselling, for selection of candidates and the applicability of the reservation have also been prescribed therein.

- 6) Now the Director of Medical Education has requested for publication of the seat matrix of the above PG courses for Selection of Candidates for allotment to the above colleges for admission during the academic year 2004-2005.

- 7) Government of Karnataka hereby notifies the intake capacity of seats and seat matrix thereof in M.Sc., Nursing & MPT Courses conducted in Government and Private Nursing Colleges and in Private Physiotherapy Colleges for the academic session 2004-2005 apportioning of 50:50 as specified in the Annexure - I, II & III.

- 8) The Tuition fee chargeable from the candidates selected under these orders during the current academic session 2004-2005 shall be in terms of the fee structure tentatively evolved by the Justice A.B.Murgod Committee for Fixation of Fee Structure in Professional Colleges as under:

Sl.No.	Course	Tuition and other fee per annum in Private Nursing & Physiotherapy Colleges
(1)	M.Sc., Nursing	Rs.80,000
(2)	Master of Physiotherapy	Rs.80,000

- 9) The other types of fee payable by the candidates shall be as prescribed in the Govt.Orders for the time being in force.

- 10) The Criteria for Selection of Candidates adoption of procedure thereof and applicability of the reservation etc, shall be as prescribed in the Rules and Govt.Orders adverted herein above.

NOTIFICATION

Sub:- Publication of intake and seat matrix of M.Sc Allied Health Sciences in Government and Private Nursing colleges during academic year 2020-21.

Vide Government Order/Notification No. HFW 18 PTD 2006, dated: 19/01/2006, Regulations called for "admission to Post Graduate, Ayurvedha, Homeopathy, Pharmacy, Nursing and Physiotherapy courses Regulations, 2006 were issued.

The Director of Medical Education has submitted a proposal of seat Matrix of Post Graduate Courses in Government and Private M.Sc Allied Health Sciences colleges in the state for the academic year 2020-21 vide reference (1).

The Government quota seats for M.Sc. Nursing Courses available in Government Nursing Colleges and in Private Nursing Colleges have been reserved 50% for in-service and 50% for merit candidates as per the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for admission to M.Sc Degree Course in Nursing (Amendment) Rules, 2002, vide reference (2) above.

In Government Order No. HFW 211 RGU 2016 dated:28/09/2016, the Percentage of seat sharing in the Private Nursing and Physiotherapy colleges in the State has been published with respect to Post Graduate Courses for the academic year 2018-2019, in the ratio of 25:75, 25% as the Government Quota and 75 % of Management Quota respectively. This ratio is applicable for 2020-21 academic year also.

The Managements of Private Allied Health Sciences Institutions in the State Shall fill their management quota seats by following the Norms as prescribed by the Government of Karnataka and the concerned Apex bodies.


Therefore, on par with M.Sc. Nursing Course, the Government of Karnataka hereby determines the intake U/s 45 (10) (b) of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Act, 1994 and publishes the Seat Matrix there under for M.Sc. Allied Health Science Courses conducted in Government and Private Nursing Colleges applicable for the current academic year 2020-21 as specified in the Annexure from 1 to 4.

As per the Government order HFW 84 MMC 2019, Dated: 31.08.2019 Directorate of Medical Education shall conduct the counseling for allotment to the M.Sc. Allied Health Science Courses in the Government Colleges and Private Colleges Seats for the academic year 2020-21.

The Tuition fee chargeable in Government colleges and Government seats in Private colleges for M.Sc. Allied Health Sciences shall be as per the rates prescribed for M.Sc. Nursing courses in the Government Orders issued from time to time.

The admission of the candidates is subject to the approval by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore as per the intake fixed for the academic year 2020-21 by the University.
