With reference to the above, find enclosed herewith the following with respect to Academic Eligibility for admission to VTU Post graduate Programmes MBA/MCA/M.Tech./M.Arch.

- 1. Academic Eligibility for seeking admission to MBA/ MCA/M.Tech..M.Arch. as per KEA Information
- 2. Course Wise Eligibility to VTU M.Tech. programmes (Refer this office Circular: VTU/Aca/1-9/2020-
- 3. Entry level qualifications acquired through Distance Education mode are not considered for admission to
- 4. The academic eligibility is to be determined by considering all the subjects reflected in the marks cards of qualifying examination i.e. including audit courses and additional subject which are not considered for
- 5. The Conversion formula for conversion of CGPA into percentage is as below: Percentage of Marks Secured, P = [CGPA earned -0.75] x 10
- 6. Undergraduate programmes obtained from The Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers, New Delhi is not considered for admission to VTU M.Tech. programmes (E.C. Res. No. 2.2.3 dated 10-6-2014).
- 7. The academic eligibility of the candidate being admitted shall be verified correctly.
- Due verification has to be made about the authenticity of University from which the candidate has obtained his/her qualifying degree.
- 9. The relaxation in minimum percentage is extended only to Karnataka candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Cat-I. This rule is also applicable to the candidates seeking admission under management quota also.

- 10. Admission of In-Service Candidates should be sent along with 'No Objection Certificate' from the employer.
- 11. Non-employed candidates: have to submit an undertaking as per the enclosed format to the Principal of the college and copy of the same shall be forwarded to the University.

The violation, if any, in this regard will be seriously viewed and the Principal of the concerned college will be held responsible.

Admission Eligibility for PG admissions 2020-21, regarding...

Reference Regulations Governing PG Degrees of VTU

Admission eligibility to PG-programmes of the University, as per regulations governing PG programmes is "the candidates who have passed prescribed qualifying examination with not less than 50% (CGPA-not less than 5.75) of the marks in the aggregate of all the years of the degree examination for general category students. However in the case of candidates belongs to SC/ST and Category I, the aggregate percentage of marks in the prescribed qualifying examination shall not be less than 45% (CGPA not less than 5.25). Rounding off of percentage secured in the qualifying examination is not permissible. (Reservation is applicable only for Karnataka Candidates)".

Please note that for the students who qualify from VTU, the formula for conversion of marks from CGPA to the percentage is- Percentage of marks = (CGPA-0.75) x 10
